 - How and why it broke down.
- * Why are the Aboriginal people angry with the Europeans?
 - ➤ What was the impact of the breakdown for the Aboriginal people
- * Has there been violence between the two groups? Mention 1 2 examples

Your answer should be approximately 500 words (using size 12 font).
